





KANOKO TAKAYA



Kanoko was born and raised in Kyoto, Japan. She was first introduced to Indonesia's vast variety of cultures through her mother, who would often visit Bali, Indonesia. Through these travels, her love for Indonesian culture blossomed.

After graduating from Kyoto Seika, majoring in Visual Design, Kanoko moved to Indonesia in 2014. She continued her studies at Indonesia University of the Arts (ISI), Surakarta (Solo), Central Java. During her two years in Solo, Kanoko began uncovering traditional Indonesian culture in depth - particularly fascinated by the "Bobung" mask in Yogyakarta (Central Java) and the mask of Malang (East Java). The Indonesian masks captivated her through the many evocative expressions; differing from Japanese masks which show little expression in their detailed

In her third year in Indonesia, Kanoko moved to Bali and worked as an in-house artist for Pithecanthropus under her own brand, Kanokon until late 2019. Throughout her journey, Kanoko has produced three different series of artworks: the Indonesian series, the Inner Series, and the Movement Series.

RUDY MURDOCK

WISNU AJI SASAKA



Wisnu Aji Sasaka is a visual artist from Yogyakarta, Indonesia. In creating his paintings, he is influenced by individual phenomena and surrealism, which become his visual language. As a surrealist painter, Wisnu weaves together the interplay of individual experiences and surrealism with his personal journey family dynamics, social encounters and transforms them into metaphorical visual symbols rich with emotion.

His artistic process is inspired by works of Romanticism, which form the foundation of his struggle to express the emotional spectrum of human experience sadness, anxiety, joy emerging both from individual personality and his observations of the surrounding environment. From these essential aspects, Wisnu highlights a deep inner intuition, full of sensivity and integral to his practice.

To evoke this atmosphere, he employs a psychoanalytic surreal visual approach, constructing an imaginative space that is not entirely logical, yet profoundly emotional. Symbolic forms, dreamlike landscapes, and metaphorical objects become his way of articulating an inner world that is poetic and layered with meaning.

Visually Wisnu's works are also influenced by the historiography of his local environment, particularly the natural landscape of Rawa Pening, a lake steeped in myth that reflects the intertwined relationship between nature and spirituality. Elements such as mist, boats, water, flora, and fauna appear as representations that shape a surreal atmosphere.

Through the fusion of personal emotional depth and the visual strength of surrealism, Wisnu creates artworks that invite viewers into reflective space where sadness, joy, and dreams converge in a profound silence filled with substance.

ZITA NUELLA



Zita Nuella (b. 1998, Indonesia), known as Z, is an artist based in Bandung. A graduate of interior design, she developed her practice through the artist incubation program AMP, Atreyu Moniaga Project #12: Ad Maiora (2024).

Z's work explores the tension between self and perception, how we absorb the world, and how the world reshapes us in return. She often places herself in unfamiliar states, deliberately destabilizing what is known, to confront new ways of seeing.

For Z, identity is not a single triumph but a continual layering, something that can be erased, transformed, and reconfigured over time. Her paintings trace these shifting thresholds, where fragility and survival coexist.

She refers to these moments as "intimate universals", experiences we rarely name, yet instinctively recognize. Rather than offering resolution, her works hold space for recognition: an invitation to encounter one's own quiet transformations.
